Promotion of Students

- The overall total of all courses of optional subjects from previous semester (Land III sem, for UG courses and Lsem, of PG) is taken into consideration (a).
- The total marks of all courses of optional subjects secured by the student is taken into
 consideration and converted into percentage; further 50% of this secured mark in
 percentage is calculated (b).
- The IA marks card scored for the present/next semester (II and IV sem. UG; II sem. of PG) is calculated and further converted to 50% (c).
- The secured theory marks (b) and converted IA marks (c) is added to obtain the total marks (d) secured by the student (100 marks).
- Further, the IA marks is deducted from the total marks (d) enabling for display of the theory marks and IA marks separately in the score-card and declaration of the results.
- The practical marks scored by the previous semester are carried forward to the next semester, which remains constant for all courses of all optional.
- 7. This procedure is followed for only those candidates who have cleared and passed all the courses of the optional subjects opted in the previous semester (I and III sem. for UG courses and I sem. of PG).

Note: In case if candidate failed in the intermediate semesters, his/her even semester (both UG and PG) results will be processed immediately after the clearance of their intermediate semesters.
